VANDERBILT takes the protection of your privacy very seriously. That is why VANDERBILT International GmbH, Beringstraße 34, 65205, Wiesbaden (hereinafter referred to as VANDERBILT) operates this website in accordance with the applicable privacy and data security laws and regulations.

The following provisions outline what information we collect on this site, for what purpose, and with whom we may share it.

The legal basis of data protection stems from the Federal Data Protection Act (Bundesdatenschutzgesetz - BDSG) and the Telemedia Act (Telemediengesetz - TMG) and the privacy laws of individual countries.

Type and Purpose of data gathering

We use cookies on this site. For more information, please read our [Cookie Policy]. It also describes how to block the use of cookies and the data gathered by cookies in anonymous or pseudonymous User profiles.

Access to our website is logged for security analysis and for defence against attacks.

When you visit our website, your browser automatically sends information that is collected and stored in our server log files. These are:

- Browser type/ Browser version
- Operating system used
- Referring URL
- Host name of accessing computer
- Time of server request

This data cannot be attributed to any individual person. We do not collate this data together with other data sources. We retain the right to subsequently check this data should we have any reason to suspect illegal use.

In addition, we only collect personal data (e.g. names, addresses, telephone numbers or email addresses) in connection with the operation of our website when this information is provided to us voluntarily (e.g. through registration, contact requests, surveys, etc) and you have granted consent to the processing and use of that information.

The data entered during registration will only be used for the purpose of using our website and services. The User may receive information via email about offers or related to registration, such as changes to the scope of services or products on offer or technical matters. The data collected during the registration process are shown in the input screen, including company name, street address and house number, post code, city/town, country and telephone, commercial register number; given name; family name; email; user name; job title; industry; market position; fields of activity.

Orders may require additional information for purchase.

In principle, we use this information only for the purpose for which it was supplied, i.e. to answer your questions, to process your orders or to provide you with access to specific information or offers.

Google Analytics

The website also uses Google Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google Inc. ("Google"). Google Analytics uses "cookies", small text files stored on your computer to analyse how you use the website. The information generated by this cookie regarding your use of this website is usually transferred to a Google server in

the USA and stored there. Where IP anonymization has been activated on this website, your IP address will be truncated to only indicate that the address came from somewhere within the European Union, or for other countries party to this agreement, within the European Economic Area. Google will use this information on our behalf to evaluate the use of our website, to generate reports on website activity and other website and internet related services. The IP address transmitted to Google Analytics from your browser will not be merged with other Google data. You may block the use of cookies by altering your browser settings; but we would like to point out that this may prevent you from accessing all the features of our website.
